IN THE WASHINGTON PAPERS THIS MONTH.....

Lawyers and Senators were in the news this month, trying to help clean up the D.C. Jail of overcrowding, inadequate facilities, and you guessed it, homosexuality! This homosexuality according to the jail officials is "acute" (a cute what?) and is caused by the overcrowding of cells and dorms. Interviews were conducted to see what could be done..... General Sessions Court Judge Scally denied a man charged with Lewd and immoral soliciting a jury trial. Reason? It might lead to hundreds of jury requests in petty cases, Petty Cases???..... Madlyn Murray O'Hair is now fighting the entire cause for separation of church and State. She will soon publish a new pamphlet entitled, "Let Us Prey"..... The House Appropriations Subcommittee has released testimony concerning campus drug parties. The report states that(Post, April 4th) the parents of a coed who associates with drug takers could be absolutely certain that her morals have been deteriorating..... "Washington Bachelors Abound for Dinner, not for Marriage" the headline reads, which discusses the views of party giver Mrs. Gwen Cafritz. Craig Rodwell of MSNY taped a half-hour TV program to be seen April 23rd on local NY stations. Meanwhile in NY, many homosexuals are leaving on weekends, several of our friends have already opened thier houses at Cherry Grove. After a "gay oi'time" in Bos and Ny it was good to get back to Wash- even if it have problems!!
