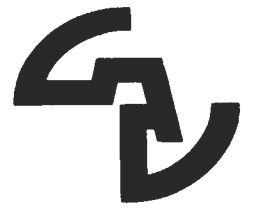

The Gay Academic Union, Inc. takes pride in announcing the publication of its quarterly *Gay Academic Union Journal: Gai Saber*. *Gai Saber* will contain scholarly information on all aspects of the study of homosexuality and gay liberation.

Gai Saber will be divided into sections for scholarly articles and papers delivered at GAU conferences; for in-depth book reviews; for news from campuses and GAU chapters; and for reports on gay studies and gay research.

The Editor-in-Chief, Ms. J. Lee Lehman of Rutgers University, commented: "This journal is the first of its kind—a truly interdisciplinary avenue for reporting research on homosexuality and gay liberation. This project is a direct result of interest generated by the Gay Liberation Movement, without which scholars would find it difficult, if not impossible to pursue research in this area."
