

## 1. Reactions to Project Turnaround Project thus far:

WMAL (7)	Station management meeting held March 26. (Report attached to last Turnaround report)
WTOP (9)	Station management meeting held April 4. (Report attached)
WRC (4)	Station management meeting held April 18. (Report in progress; a second meeting requested by the management.)
WTTG (5)	Station management meeting scheduled for April 25.
WETA (26)	No meeting set. Second letter sent 4/22/75.
WDCA (20)	Letter from station indicates that they do not want a meeting; Third letter sent 4/22/75.

2. Reactions to April 20 appearance on "Challenge" (Channel 20) were very positive. Herb Davis, the moderator, wants to do a "Parents of Gays" show in near future; interested in "Gays and Religion" but did not give firm commitment.
3. Brochures are ready. Keep one near your television set and begin to "monitor" the stations. Also, take a few extras with you to give to your gay friends. Become a TV monitoring freak--whenever you see positive or negative things on TV, write or call the stations and send carbons as recommended in the brochure.
4. Loretta Lotman has requested Jim Zais to accompany her on April 29, 30 at hearings before the Code Boards of the National Association of Broadcasters. (Radio and TV) She will give the major presentation (calling for "sexual orientation" to be inserted in code at various points) and Zais would back her up with local, Turnaround experience in dealing with the stations. Without objection, he will participate in these hearings.
5. Project members expect that after the current "negotiation" stage, Turnaround will turn its attention to communicating the gains we have made to other gay groups. Our goal is to have as many gays as possible take advantage of the new "offerings" of the stations. We are beginning to prepare a presentation on the Turnaround project for that purpose.
